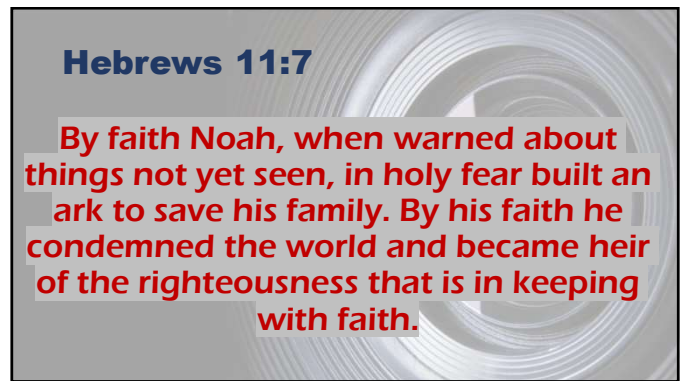

By his faith he...became heir of the righteousness that is in keeping with faith.

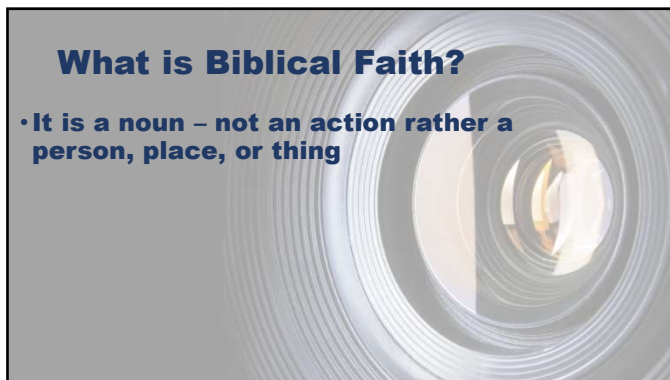
