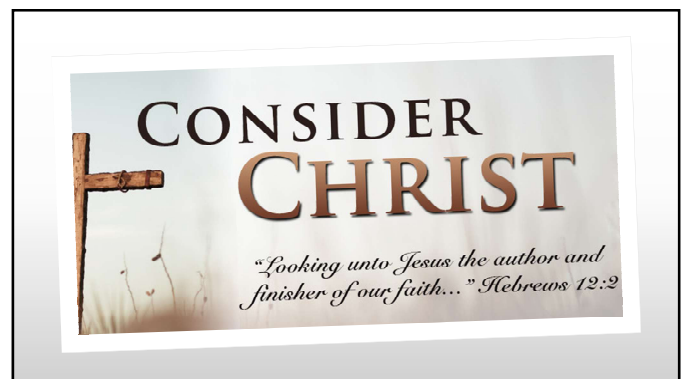
- What are the perks?
